



HOLIDAY CAMP INFORMATION

Our Holiday Camp location:

- **Calverley CofE Primary School**, Towngate, Calverley LS28 5NF

We are on the school field at the back of the school. Please register your child in the car park at the back of the school.

- Main session timings are 10:00-16:00.

At Calverley CofE we have:

- **Morning wraparound care available from 9:00-10:00.**
- **Afternoon wraparound care available from 16:00-17:00**
- Please accompany your child to register your child at the beginning of each day.
- All children are required to complete online our consent form prior to attending.
- Please inform us of any change to collection at morning registration.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL CHILDREN ATTENDING OUR HOLIDAY FOREST CAMP!!

- Your children will be required to bring their **OWN LUNCH** - Please ensure it **DOES NOT CONTAIN NUTS** in case of any other children with nut allergies.
- Drinking water will be provided to top up any bottles.
- In the case of hot weather their area natural areas of shade and we will provide other sources of shade if required.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Our activities will be on the school field and in the outdoor classroom.
- Our forest activity sessions run in all weathers (the only weather that may put a stop to sessions are lightening and extremely high wind).
- In the case of hot weather please make sure that you apply sun cream before they arrive, and they have some with them too.

There is no such thing as ‘bad weather’ only ‘the wrong clothing’. To have a positive experience, children need to be dressed appropriately, so old, inexpensive clothes are most suitable. These guidelines should help:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Waterproof Jacket & Trousers• All-in-one waterproofs are very useful, especially for younger children.• Layers – more in winter (2 isn’t enough!)• Long trousers (to avoid stinging nettles and scratching hazards)• Wellies/other waterproof boots/strong shoes/trainers available for all seasons	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Woolly hat, gloves & scarf• Sun hat (in summer).• Strictly no open toes shoes/sandals, slip-ons or crocs!• This is not an activity for pretty dresses or flammable party costumes as we may well be cooking on an open fire.
